If you have a foreign nationality, you (temporarily) live in The Netherlands and work for a multinational company, you and your spouse can apply for an expatriate membership. It offers you and your partner:

- a membership at the Noordwijkse Golfclub for a maximum period of three years.
- an annual expatriate membership fee of EUR 4.000,- per person (excluding your NGF contribution) and pay no entrance fee.
- same rights and duties as an ordinary member, with the exception of voting rights during the general member meetings.
